A maximum value of \$5,000 is offered to a candidate who intends to study in a full-time programme of tertiary education. Candidates must be citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand.

Quota New Zealand is a non-profit organization empowering woman, children, the deaf and hard-of-hearing, and people with speech difficulties in local communities. In 1919, five business women inspired to serve, founded Quota International in Buffalo New York, as the first international women's service organization. After 101 years the international body dissolved, however Quota Clubs continue to link people of all ages, occupations and nationalities.

Today, many Quota members assist women and children overcome poverty and educational and workforce challenges in 14 countries.

To apply for the Quota Scholarship you will need the following:

- Two References as set out on the Application Form
- A Personal Statement outlining your reasons for choosing the proposed course of study, academic background, work/life experience and community involvement.
- Evidence of financial need

You must be a school leaver enrolling to study full time at a New Zealand Tertiary Institution. This includes University, Technical College and other post-secondary school education facilities.
